

Instructions on how to use Cleanviro urinal tablets

New tablet installation

1. Clean the urinal by pouring two buckets of water with liquid detergent from one end of the urinal through to the other end where the drain is located until the urinal wall and floor is clean of any dirt or urine
2. Remove the drain cover, clear out any foreign objects and pour another bucket of water with liquid detergent straight onto the urinal drain
3. Mop the steps and urinal floor until dry
4. Pour 5 capfuls of the Cleanviro liquid cleaning solution (undiluted) onto the urinal drain – this is important to neutralize the urine odour that has built-up in the drain area
5. Dilute the Cleanviro liquid cleaning solution (dilution rate is 1:25) into a spray bottle. You can mix one litre of water with 5 capfuls of the liquid cleaning solution concentrate.
6. Thoroughly spray the urinal wall and the steps. Approximately, for a one square metre area, you should spray the cleaning solution about 15 times.
7. Simply toss the Cleanviro urinal tablet onto the urinal – ideally space the tablets by about a metre plus one tablet, (example if you have a 3 metre-long urinal, place 4 urinal tablets, and if it is a 4 metre-long urinal, place 5 urinal tablets).

Daily maintenance

Daily maintenance of the urinal is the same process as above, except that the existing urinal tablet has to be set aside first before pouring the water with liquid detergent.

During peak-period

The Cleanviro urinal tablets is designed to encapsulate and emulsify all urine odour and leave the area odour-free and with mild fragrance, however there will be some areas around the urinal where the tablet cannot neutralize the odour (ie, wall, sidesteps) so once or twice during the day (especially during peak periods) , it is strongly recommended that the cleaning solution be sprayed in the wall , floor and sidesteps to compensate the effect of the tablet. (Same spray volume as described above, about 15 sprays per square metre)

Replacement of the tablet

The tablet should last between 2-4 weeks depending on how heavy the use of the urinal. As the tablet shrinks in size, the colour will become paler and will look a bit soggy, but that is completely natural due to constant exposure to ammonia acids from urine. When the tablets become too small that it is smaller than a 50 cent coin, or it's more than 4 weeks, or you notice that the effectivity of the tablet is reduced, its time to replace the urinal tablets.
